

TECHNOLOGY/NETWORK ACCEPTABLE USE

The Board encourages and promotes the use of technology in education. All use of technology must be in support of and be consistent with, purposes of the District. The individual user shall accept responsibility of acceptable use of the available technologies. To ensure that students, staff, parents and other community members can take advantage of the technologies available in a responsible manner, the Superintendent shall develop technology and network acceptable use guidelines as follows:

Technology Use Procedures are for students. They apply to the acceptable use of all technology resources including voice, video and data. Violations of these procedures constitute a violation of the "Student Code of Conduct".

Network Acceptable Use Policy is for all students, staff, parents and other community members. It describes the acceptable usage and responsibilities of the individual users of the District's network. Each user shall complete a Network Registration Agreement to comply with the Policy. Violations of the Network Acceptable Use Policy may be violations of the "Student Code of Conduct", employee contract or state/federal law.

Web Page Development applies to the District, building, classroom or department website to allow staff to produce electronic information about the District, the curriculum and the educational activities of the District's schools. Contents of all pages attached or linked to/from the District website must be directly related to and/or be in support of education and must comply with District policies as well as local, state and federal laws. Electronic publications will be subject to the same policies and standards as print publications.

The District's website is an official District publication. All text and photographs appearing on the website or subsequent pages linked to it are copyrighted and should not be reproduced without written permission from the Superintendent.

The Superintendent will be responsible for assuring proper maintenance of the District's website. The Superintendent will develop procedures for appropriate use of the District's network capabilities and proper conduct of each web developer.
